Sir,

I am directed to state that the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) has accorded approval to Nagar Yuvak Shikshan Sanstha's College of Engineering, Airoli, New Bombay to conduct the following degree courses with intake shown against each for the academic year 1991-92 only:-

The above approval is subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:

1. The management including the Governing Council of the College shall be formed as per AICTE guidelines and also the Chairman shall be appointed as per AICTE norms.
2. The infrastructural and other facilities including equipment, faculty etc. shall be provided as recommended by the Expert Committee which visited the College on Sept. 17, 1990 and also as per AICTE norms and standards.
3. Admissions shall be made on merit as per the guidelines issued by the AICTE and no capitation or donation of any kind shall be charged for admissions.
4. The faculty shall be selected on an All India basis by open selection according to qualifications and experience laid down by the AICTE.
5. The accounts of the College shall be audited by a

Chartered Accountant and be open for inspection by the AICTE or anybody authorized by it.

6. The College shall follow strictly any further conditions as may be laid down by the AICTE from time to time.
7. In the event of non-compliance by the Society or the College with the above conditions, the AICTE will be free to take measures for the closure of the program and withdrawal of its approval without consideration of any related issues and that all liabilities due to closure would be that of the Society and/or the College.
8. An Expert Committee of the Western Regional Committee (WRC) will visit the College in January/February, 1992 to assess compliance with the above conditions. Further approval or otherwise of engineering degree program after academic year 1991-92 will be considered by this Council based on the report of the Expert Committee as stated above.

The details of the recommendations of the Expert Committee which visited the College on Sept. 17, 1990 including the estimated recurring and non-recurring expenditure will be communicated to you and to the College by the WRC.

You are requested to kindly take necessary action in the matter and keep the WRC, Bombay and this Council informed of the progress made in this behalf.

Sub: Extension of Approval to Nagar Yuvak Shikshan Sanstha's College of Engineering, Airoli, New Bombay and approval for introduction of a new degree course.

Sir,

I am directed to state that on consideration of the observations made by the Expert Committees which visited the College on 28.1.1992 & 26.4.1992 and the recommendations made by the Chairman of Western Regional Committee (WRC), the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) has accorded approval to the Nagar Yuvak Shikshan Sanstha's College of Engineering, Airoli, New Bombay to continue the conduct of the degree courses in Civil Engineering and Electronics Engineering with intakes of 120 (one hundred twenty) each during the academic year 1992-93 and also for introduction of a new degree course in Computer Engineering with an intake of 60 (sixty) for the academic year 1992-93 only, subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:

- (1) The College shall provide the teaching staff during various academic years as per details given below:

- (2) The required technical supporting staff shall be recruited to remove the deficiencies within two years.
- (3) The Environmental Laboratory in the Civil Engineering and the Communication Laboratory in the Electronics Engineering Department shall be set up by May, 1993.
- (4) The building and class-rooms shall be solely utilised for conducting the Degree Engineering courses and no other course shall be conducted in the premises of the existing Engineering College. The laboratories, class rooms and workshops shall be provided separately and the equipment provided in the laboratory shall be such that they are used by the students for actual performance, not for demonstration only.
- (5) The number of students per batch in the workshops and during practicals shall not exceed 15.
- (6) The area of the library should be 380 sqm. Number of books in the library shall be increased by 1,000 by June 1993.
- (7) No new course shall be started in the Engineering College without the prior approval of the AICTE.
- (8) The intake in any year in any of the AICTE approved courses shall not be altered without the prior approval of the AICTE.
- (9) The Management including the Governing Council of the College shall be constituted as per the AICTE guidelines and also the Chairman shall be appointed as per the AICTE guidelines.
- (10) Admissions shall be made on merit as per the guidelines issued by the AICTE and no capitation or donation of any kind shall be charged for admissions.
- (11) The tuition and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the State Government within the overall criteria prescribed by the AICTE from time to time.
- (12) The teaching staff shall be recruited on an All India basis by open selection, and as per procedure, qualifications, experience, etc. as prescribed by the AICTE from time to time. State-based selection would be permissible for such posts for which the State Government prescribes "State-based selection" as a general policy.
- (13) The accounts of the College shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant and be open for inspection by the AICTE or anybody authorized by it.
- (14) The College shall submit a duly registered revised specific undertaking by August 31, 1992.
